## SUMMARY

This document outlines the procedures for selecting participants in the Open Class Olympic Rifle events for 2026 International competitions. *See Appendix A for a calendar of the 2026 ISSF competitions.*

Selection Procedures for Junior Class, Paralympic, non-Olympic, and non-Paralympic events are found in separate documents.

## 1. ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Athletes must fulfill the following requirements to be eligible to compete in the 2026 international events covered by these Selection Procedures.

- Be a USA citizen with a valid passport.
- Be a USA Shooting member in good standing.
- Abide by the eligibility requirements of the International Shooting Sports Federation (ISSF), the United States Olympic and Paralympic Committee (USOPC), the US Center for SafeSport, the United States Anti-Doping Agency (USADA), and the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA).
- Must comply with the new 2026 ISSF Equipment Rules to qualify to compete in international competitions.

## 2. SELECTION FOR THE 2026 ISSF WORLD CUP 1: GRANADA, ESP

*Quick view: Selections for this competition are from the Final 2025 Ranking List.*

### **2.1. Ranking for the World Cup Granada Selection**

- 2.1.1. Nominations to compete in World Cup Granada will be based on the Final 2025 Ranking List (*Appendix B*).
- 2.1.2. The 2025 Final Ranking List is based on 2025 Selection Procedures.
- 2.1.3. Only National Team and National Development Team members on the Final 2025 Ranking List will be eligible for nominations.

### **2.2. Individual Events**

- 2.2.1. Nominations will be extended in each individual event in order of ranking until all World Cup positions are filled or until all 2025 Ranking List National Team and National Development Team members have received a nomination, whichever comes first.
- 2.2.2. Nominations must be accepted no later than March 1, 2026. In the event an athlete accepts a nomination after the acceptance deadline and that

entry can still be accepted by the competition's Organizing Committee, that athlete will not displace an athlete entered in an in-competition slot even if ranked higher in the Selection.

### **2.3. Mixed Team Events**

- 2.3.1. Mixed Teams will be comprised of athletes competing in the Individual Air Rifle events.
- 2.3.2. **Air Rifle Mixed Team USA 1** will be comprised of the highest ranked Male and highest ranked Female from the World Cup Granada Selection who are participating in the Individual Air Rifle events and who accept the Mixed Team USA 1 nomination.
- 2.3.3. **Air Rifle Mixed Team USA 2** will be comprised of the second highest ranked Male and second highest ranked Female from the World Cup Granada Selection who are participating in the Individual Air Rifle events and who accept the Mixed Team USA 2 nomination.
- 2.3.4. Athletes may decline a nomination to a Mixed Team and be replaced by the next ranked athlete no later than noon two days prior to the start of the Mixed Team event (ISSF Rule 6.18.1.4).

## **3. SELECTION FOR THE 2026 ISSF WORLD CUP 2: MUNICH, GER**

*Quick view: Selections for this competition are from the single stand-alone 2026 Spring Selection Match. The same Selection results will be used for World Cup Hangzhou.*

### **3.1. Ranking for the World Cup Munich Selection**

- 3.1.1. Nominations to compete in World Cup Munich will be based on the results of the March, 2026, USA Shooting Spring Selection Match held in Colorado Springs, CO.
- 3.1.2. The ranking used for Selection will be from the aggregate of two (2) ISSF qualification courses of fire and one (1) Final.
  - 3.1.2.1. Athletes will qualify for the Final based on the aggregate of the two (2) ISSF qualification courses of fire.
  - 3.1.2.2. Athletes will carry their aggregate qualification score into the Final (the Final will not start from zero). The score from each Finals shot will be added to the aggregate qualification score. Eliminations will occur after the same number of shots as in an ISSF Final but will be based on the total of the aggregate qualification score and all Finals shots up to that elimination point. *See Appendix C for an example of how the combined qualification and Finals scores will be used for eliminations.*
- 3.1.3. Only the Finalists (athletes ranked 1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> place) will be eligible for a nomination.

### **3.2. Individual Events**

- 3.2.1. Nominations will be extended in each individual event in order of ranking until all World Cup positions are filled or until all Finalists (athletes ranked 1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> place) have received a nomination, whichever comes first.
- 3.2.2. Any remaining open slots will revert to development slots or remain unfilled. Development slots may be filled by current National Team and National Development Team members at the National Shotgun Manager's discretion upon approval of the USA Shooting Selection Committee.
- 3.2.3. Nominations must be accepted no later than April 1, 2026. In the event an athlete accepts a nomination after the acceptance deadline and that entry can still be accepted by the competition's Organizing Committee, that athlete will not displace an athlete entered in an in-competition slot even if ranked higher in the Selection.

### **3.3. Mixed Team Events**

- 3.3.1. Mixed Teams will be comprised of athletes competing in the Individual Air Rifle events.
- 3.3.2. **Air Rifle Mixed Team USA 1** will be comprised of the highest ranked Male and highest ranked Female from the World Cup Munich Selection who are participating in the Individual Air Rifle events and who accept the Mixed Team USA 1 nomination.
- 3.3.3. **Air Rifle Mixed Team USA 2** will be comprised of the second highest ranked Male and second highest ranked Female from the World Cup Munich Selection who are participating in the Individual Air Rifle events and who accept the Mixed Team USA 2 nomination.
- 3.3.4. Athletes may decline a nomination to a Mixed Team and be replaced by the next ranked athlete no later than noon two days prior to the start of the Mixed Team event (ISSF Rule 6.18.1.4).

## **4. SELECTION FOR THE 2026 ISSF WORLD CUP 3: HANGZHOU, CHN**

*Quick view: Selections for this competition are from the single stand-alone 2026 Spring Selection Match. The same Selection results will be used for World Cup Munich.*

### **4.1. Ranking for the World Cup Hangzhou Selection**

- 4.1.1. Nominations to compete in World Cup Hangzhou will be based on the results of the March, 2026, USA Shooting Spring Selection Match held in Colorado Springs, CO.
- 4.1.2. The ranking used for Selection will be from the aggregate of two (2) ISSF qualification courses of fire and one (1) Final.

- 4.1.2.1. Athletes will qualify for the Final based on the aggregate of the two (2) ISSF qualification courses of fire.
- 4.1.2.2. Athletes will carry their aggregate qualification score into the Final (the Final will not start from zero). The score from each Finals shot will be added to the aggregate qualification score. Eliminations will occur after the same number of shots as in an ISSF Final but will be based on the total of the aggregate qualification score and all Finals shots up to that elimination point. *See Appendix C for an example of how the combined qualification and Finals scores will be used for eliminations.*
- 4.1.3. Only the Finalists (athletes ranked 1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> place) will be eligible for a nomination.

#### **4.2. Individual Events**

- 4.2.1. Nominations will be extended in each individual event in order of ranking until all World Cup positions are filled or until all Finalists (athletes ranked 1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> place) have received a nomination, whichever comes first.
- 4.2.2. Any remaining open slots will revert to development slots or remain unfilled. Development slots may be filled by current National Team and National Development Team members at the National Shotgun Manager's discretion upon approval of the USA Shooting Selection Committee.
- 4.2.3. Nominations must be accepted no later than May 20, 2026. In the event an athlete accepts a nomination after the acceptance deadline and that entry can still be accepted by the competition's Organizing Committee, that athlete will not displace an athlete entered in an in-competition slot even if ranked higher in the Selection.

#### **4.3. Mixed Team Events**

- 4.3.1. Mixed Teams will be comprised of athletes competing in the Individual Air Rifle events.
- 4.3.2. **Air Rifle Mixed Team USA 1** will be comprised of the highest ranked Male and highest ranked Female from the World Cup Hangzhou Selection who are participating in the Individual Air Rifle events and who accept the Mixed Team USA 1 nomination.
- 4.3.3. **Air Rifle Mixed Team USA 2** will be comprised of the second highest ranked Male and second highest ranked Female from the World Cup Hangzhou Selection who are participating in the Individual Air Rifle events and who accept the Mixed Team USA 2 nomination.
- 4.3.4. Athletes may decline a nomination to a Mixed Team and be replaced by the next ranked athlete no later than noon two days prior to the start of the Mixed Team event (ISSF Rule 6.18.1.4).

## 5. SELECTION FOR THE 2026 ISSF WORLD CUP 4: CAIRO, EGY

*Quick view: Selections for this competition are from a two-part Selection Match series combining the 2026 USA Shooting National Championships and the 2026 USA Shooting Fall Selection Match. The same Selection results will be used for the World Championship Team and the Championship of the Americas Team.*

### 5.1. Ranking for the World Cup Cairo Selection

- 5.1.1. Nominations to compete in World Cup Cairo will be based on the combined results of the 2026 USA Shooting National Championships and the 2026 USA Shooting Fall Selection Match.
- 5.1.2. The ranking used for Selection will be from the total aggregate of the two (2) ISSF qualification courses of fire at the 2026 USA Shooting National Championships, the two (2) ISSF qualification courses of fire at the 2026 Fall Selection Match, and the one (1) Final at the 2026 Fall Selection Match. The Final from the 2026 USA Shooting National Championships will not be used for Selection.
  - 5.1.2.1. Athletes will qualify for the Final at the 2026 USA Shooting Fall Selection Match based on the aggregate of the two (2) qualification courses of fire at the 2026 USA Shooting National Championships and the two (2) qualification courses of fire at the 2026 Fall Selection Match (the aggregate of four (4) total qualification courses of fire).
  - 5.1.2.2. Athletes will carry their aggregate qualification score into the Final (the Final will not start from zero). The score from each Finals shot will be added to the aggregate qualification score. Eliminations will occur after the same number of shots as in an ISSF Final but will be based on the total of the aggregate qualification score and all Finals shots up to that elimination point. *See Appendix C for an example of how the combined qualification and Finals scores will be used for eliminations.*
- 5.1.3. Only the Finalists (athletes ranked 1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> place) will be eligible for a nomination.

### 5.2. Individual Events

- 5.2.1. Nominations will be extended in each individual event in order of ranking until all World Cup positions are filled or until all Finalists (athletes ranked 1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> place) have received a nomination, whichever comes first.
- 5.2.2. Any remaining open slots will revert to development slots or remain unfilled. Development slots may be filled by current National Team and National Development Team members at the National Shotgun Manager's discretion upon approval of the USA Shooting Selection Committee.

- 5.2.3. Nominations must be accepted no later than 7 days after the conclusion of the 2026 USA Shooting Fall Selection Match. In the event an athlete accepts a nomination after the acceptance deadline and that entry can still be accepted by the competition's Organizing Committee, that athlete will not displace an athlete entered in an in-competition slot even if ranked higher in the Selection.

### **5.3. Mixed Team Events**

- 5.3.1. Mixed Teams will be comprised of athletes competing in the Individual Air Rifle events.
- 5.3.2. **Air Rifle Mixed Team USA 1** will be comprised of the highest ranked Male and highest ranked Female from the World Cup Cairo Selection who are participating in the Individual Air Rifle events and who accept the Mixed Team USA 1 nomination.
- 5.3.3. **Air Rifle Mixed Team USA 2** will be comprised of the second highest ranked Male and second highest ranked Female from the World Cup Cairo Selection who are participating in the Individual Air Rifle events and who accept the Mixed Team USA 2 nomination.
- 5.3.4. Athletes may decline a nomination to a Mixed Team and be replaced by the next ranked athlete no later than noon two days prior to the start of the Mixed Team event (ISSF Rule 6.18.1.4).

## **6. SELECTION FOR THE 2026 ISSF WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS:**

### **DOHA, QAT**

*Quick view: Selections for this competition are from a two-part Selection Match series combining the 2026 USA Shooting National Championships and the 2026 USA Shooting Fall Selection Match. The same Selection results will be used for the World Cup Cairo and the Championship of the Americas Team.*

### **6.1. Ranking for the ISSF World Championships Selection**

- 6.1.1. Nominations to compete in 2026 ISSF World Championships will be based on the combined results of the 2026 USA Shooting National Championships and the 2026 USA Shooting Fall Selection Match.
- 6.1.2. The ranking used for Selection will be from the total aggregate of the two (2) ISSF qualification courses of fire at the 2026 USA Shooting National Championships, the two (2) ISSF qualification courses of fire at the 2026 Fall Selection Match, and the one (1) Final at the 2026 Fall Selection Match. The Final from the 2026 USA Shooting National Championships will not be used for Selection.
  - 6.1.2.1. Athletes will qualify for the Final at the 2026 USA Shooting Fall Selection Match based on the aggregate of the two (2)

qualification courses of fire at the 2026 USA Shooting National Championships and the two (2) qualification courses of fire at the 2026 Fall Selection Match (the aggregate of four (4) total qualification courses of fire).

6.1.2.2. Athletes will carry their aggregate qualification score into the Final (the Final will not start from zero). The score from each Finals shot will be added to the aggregate qualification score. Eliminations will occur after the same number of shots as in an ISSF Final but will be based on the total of the aggregate qualification score and all Finals shots up to that elimination point. *See Appendix C for an example of how the combined qualification and Finals scores will be used for eliminations.*

6.1.3. Only the Finalists (athletes ranked 1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> place) will be eligible for a nomination.

## **6.2. Individual Events**

6.2.1. Nominations will be extended in each individual event in order of ranking until all World Championship positions are filled or until all Finalists (athletes ranked 1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> place) have received a nomination, whichever comes first.

6.2.2. Any remaining open slots will revert to development slots or remain unfilled. Development slots may be filled by current National Team and National Development Team members at the National Shotgun Manager's discretion upon approval of the USA Shooting Selection Committee.

6.2.3. Nominations must be accepted no later than 7 days after the conclusion of the 2026 USA Shooting Fall Selection Match. In the event an athlete accepts a nomination after the acceptance deadline and that entry can still be accepted by the competition's Organizing Committee, that athlete will not displace an athlete entered in an in-competition slot even if ranked higher in the Selection.

## **6.3. Mixed Team Events**

6.3.1. Mixed Teams will be comprised of athletes competing in the Individual Air Rifle events.

6.3.2. **Air Rifle Mixed Team USA 1** will be comprised of the highest ranked Male and highest ranked Female from the ISSF World Championships Selection who are participating in the Individual Air Rifle events and who accept the Mixed Team USA 1 nomination.

6.3.3. **Air Rifle Mixed Team USA 2** will be comprised of the second highest ranked Male and second highest ranked Female from the ISSF World Championships Selection who are participating in the Individual Air Rifle events and who accept the Mixed Team USA 2 nomination.

- 6.3.4. Athletes may decline a nomination to a Mixed Team and be replaced by the next ranked athlete no later than noon two days prior to the start of the Mixed Team event (ISSF Rule 6.18.1.4).

#### **6.4. Team Events**

- 6.4.1. Team Events (typically Three-Member Teams) will be filled by athletes who have qualified for the individual events and are in attendance at the competition. There will be no separate Team-only slots available.
- 6.4.2. Teams will be comprised of the highest ranked athletes in order of Selection ranking who are participating in the corresponding individual event.
- 6.4.3. If there are not enough athletes available from the corresponding individual event, athletes competing in other individual events can be nominated for a Team Event slot, provided they were a Finalist (athletes ranked 1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> place) in the corresponding individual event at the Selection. Nominations will be offered in the order of Selection ranking in that corresponding event.

#### **6.5. Non-Olympic Individual and Team Events**

- 6.5.1. Selections for all non-Olympic individual and team events are separate from these Selection Procedures and can be found on the USA Shooting website.
- 6.5.2. 50m Rifle Prone individual and team slots not filled by non-Olympic Event Selections may be filled by athletes who are already competing in the 50m Smallbore Rifle 3-Positions event at that competition. These athletes will be nominated in order of their ranking in the 50m Smallbore Rifle 3-Positions event until all slots are filled or no eligible Smallbore Rifle 3-Positions athletes remain.

## **7. SELECTION FOR THE 2026 ISSF CHAMPIONSHIP OF THE AMERICAS: LIMA, PUR**

*Quick view: Selections for this competition are from a two-part Selection Match series combining the 2026 USA Shooting National Championships and the 2026 USA Shooting Fall Selection Match. The same Selection results will be used for the World Cup Cairo and the ISSF World Championships.*

#### **7.1. Ranking for the ISSF Championship of the Americas Selection**

- 7.1.1. Nominations to compete in 2026 ISSF Championship of the Americas will be based on the combined results of the 2026 USA Shooting National Championships and the 2026 USA Shooting Fall Selection Match.

- 7.1.2. The ranking used for Selection will be from the total aggregate of the two (2) ISSF qualification courses of fire at the 2026 USA Shooting National Championships, the two (2) ISSF qualification courses of fire at the 2026 Fall Selection Match, and the one (1) Final at the 2026 Fall Selection Match. The Final from the 2026 USA Shooting National Championships will not be used for Selection.
- 7.1.2.1. Athletes will qualify for the Final at the 2026 USA Shooting Fall Selection Match based on the aggregate of the two (2) qualification courses of fire at the 2026 USA Shooting National Championships and the two (2) qualification courses of fire at the 2026 Fall Selection Match (the aggregate of four (4) total qualification courses of fire).
- 7.1.2.2. Athletes will carry their aggregate qualification score into the Final (the Final will not start from zero). The score from each Finals shot will be added to the aggregate qualification score. Eliminations will occur after the same number of shots as in an ISSF Final but will be based on the total of the aggregate qualification score and all Finals shots up to that elimination point. *See Appendix C for an example of how the combined qualification and Finals scores will be used for eliminations.*
- 7.1.3. Only the Finalists (athletes ranked 1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> place) will be eligible for a nomination.

## **7.2. Individual Events**

- 7.2.1. Nominations will be extended in each individual event in order of ranking until all World Championship positions are filled or until all Finalists (athletes ranked 1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> place) have received a nomination, whichever comes first.
- 7.2.2. Any remaining open slots will revert to development slots or remain unfilled. Development slots may be filled by current National Team and National Development Team members at the National Shotgun Manager's discretion upon approval of the USA Shooting Selection Committee.
- 7.2.3. Nominations must be accepted no later than 7 days after the conclusion of the 2026 USA Shooting Fall Selection Match. In the event an athlete accepts a nomination after the acceptance deadline and that entry can still be accepted by the competition's Organizing Committee, that athlete will not displace an athlete entered in an in-competition slot even if ranked higher in the Selection.

## **7.3. Mixed Team Events**

- 7.3.1. Mixed Teams will be comprised of athletes competing in the Individual Air Rifle events.

- 7.3.2. **Air Rifle Mixed Team USA 1** will be comprised of the highest ranked Male and highest ranked Female from the ISSF Championship of the Americas Selection who are participating in the Individual Air Rifle events and who accept the Mixed Team USA 1 nomination.
- 7.3.3. **Air Rifle Mixed Team USA 2** will be comprised of the second highest ranked Male and second highest ranked Female from the ISSF Championship of the Americas Selection who are participating in the Individual Air Rifle events and who accept the Mixed Team USA 2 nomination.
- 7.3.4. Athletes may decline a nomination to a Mixed Team and be replaced by the next ranked athlete no later than noon two days prior to the start of the Mixed Team event (ISSF Rule 6.18.1.4).

#### **7.4. Team Events**

- 7.4.1. Team Events (typically Three-Member Teams) will be filled by athletes who have qualified for the individual events and are in attendance at the competition. There will be no separate Team-only slots available.
- 7.4.2. Teams will be comprised of the highest ranked athletes in order of Selection ranking who are participating in the corresponding individual event.
- 7.4.3. If there are not enough athletes available from the corresponding individual event, athletes competing in other individual events can be nominated for a Team Event slot, provided they were a Finalist (athletes ranked 1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> place) in the corresponding individual event at the Selection. Nominations will be offered in the order of Selection ranking in that corresponding event.

#### **7.5. Non-Olympic Individual and Team Events**

- 7.5.1. Selections for all non-Olympic individual and team events are separate from these Selection Procedures and can be found on the USA Shooting website.
- 7.5.2. 50m Rifle Prone individual and team slots not filled by non-Olympic Event Selections may be filled by athletes who are already competing in the 50m Smallbore Rifle 3-Positions event at that competition. These athletes will be nominated in order of their ranking in the 50m Smallbore Rifle 3-Positions event until all slots are filled or no eligible Smallbore Rifle 3-Positions athletes remain.

## **8. SELECTION FOR THE 2026 ISSF WORLD CUP FINAL: ROME, ITA**

Participation in the 2026 ISSF World Cup Final is by ISSF invitation only and based on performances in the last 12 months of ISSF competitions. Details can be found on the ISSF website at <https://www.issf-sports.org/competitions/world-cup-final>

## 9. SELECTION FOR OTHER INTERNATIONAL COMPETITIONS REQUIRING ENTRIES THROUGH USA SHOOTING

### 9.1. Ranking for Selection

- 9.1.1. The Selection criteria used for nominations to compete in non-ISSF international competitions that require entries submitted through a country's federation will depend on the timeframe of the international competition.
- 9.1.2. **January 1 to May 15, 2026.** Initial nominations for individual and team slots in international competitions starting between January 1 and May 15, 2026, will be based on the Final 2025 Ranking List. Nominations will be given in order of ranking from the Final 2025 Ranking List until all available slots are filled or until all National Team and National Development Team members on the 2025 Final Ranking List have received a nomination, whichever comes first. Any remaining open slots will revert to development slots or remain unfilled. Development slots may be filled by current National Futures Team members at the National Rifle Manager's discretion upon approval of the USA Shooting Selection Committee.
- 9.1.3. **May 16 to September 30, 2026.** Initial nominations for individual and team slots in international competitions starting between May 16 and September 30, 2026, will be based on the 2026 USA Shooting Spring Selection Match. Nominations will be given in order of ranking from the results of the 2026 USA Shooting Spring Selection Match until all slots are filled or until all Finalists (1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> place) have received a nomination, whichever comes first. Any remaining open slots will revert to development slots or remain unfilled. Development slots may be filled by current National Team, National Development Team, and National Futures Team members at the National Rifle Manager's discretion upon approval of the USA Shooting Selection Committee.
- 9.1.4. **October 1 to December 31, 2026.** Initial nominations for individual and team slots in international competitions starting between October 1 and December 31, 2026, will be based on the two-part Selection that includes the 2026 USA Shooting National Championships qualification scores, the 2026 USA Shooting Fall Selection Match qualification scores, and the 2026 USA Shooting Fall Selection Match Final. Nominations will be given in order of ranking from the total aggregate of the two-part Selection until all slots are filled or until all Finalists (1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> place) have received a nomination, whichever comes first. Any remaining open slots will revert

to development slots or remain unfilled. Development slots may be filled by current National Team, National Development Team, and National Futures Team members at the National Rifle Manager's discretion upon approval of the USA Shooting Selection Committee.

#### **9.2. Nomination Deadline**

Nominations must be accepted no later than 7 days before the competition entry deadline listed by the competition organizing committee.

## **10. SELECTION FOR OTHER INTERNATIONAL COMPETITIONS NOT REQUIRING ENTRIES THROUGH USA SHOOTING**

### **10.1. Ranking for Selection**

10.1.1. Athletes may enter any international competition that does not require entries submitted through a country's federation by requesting a sanction from USA Shooting. The sanctioning request must include how athletes are selected for the competition and how the participating athletes' health and well-being will be ensured (for example, by demonstrating that SafeSport protocols will be followed).

10.1.2. USA Shooting may enter athletes as a delegation in any international competition that does not require entries submitted through a country's federation. These are considered development slots and may be filled by current National Team, National Development Team, and National Futures Team members at the National Rifle Manager's discretion upon approval of the USA Shooting Selection Committee.

## **11. SUBSTITUTIONS**

### **11.1. Substitutions for ISSF and Non-ISSF International Competitions**

11.1.1. **ISSF Competitions:** If an athlete vacates a slot for any reason, the next ranked eligible athlete will be substituted into that slot as long as the substitution can be made within the ISSF's and Competition Organizing Committee's entry deadlines. Athletes ranked in the Top Eight of the Selection (the Finalists) are eligible to fill in as substitutions.

11.1.2. **Non-ISSF Competitions:** If an athlete vacates a slot for any reason, the slot may be filled by current National Team, National Development Team, and National Futures Team members at the National Rifle Manager's discretion upon approval of the USA Shooting Selection Committee.

11.1.3.If the substitution occurs at the competition, substitutions will come from the athletes already in attendance at the competition. Substitutions will be offered in order of Selection ranking.

11.1.4.Reasons for vacating a slot include but are not limited to declining the nomination, withdrawing from the competition, being removed from the competition by USA Shooting for a Code of Conduct violation, and being removed from the competition or deemed ineligible to compete by the ISSF or the Competition Organizing Committee.

## 12. RULES USED FOR USA SHOOTING SELECTION MATCHES

### 12.1. New 2026 ISSF Rifle Equipment Rules

Athletes must conform to the new 2026 ISSF Rifle Equipment Rules to qualify for the Final at USA Shooting Selection Matches and to qualify to compete in international competitions.

## 13. FUNDING FOR INTERNATIONAL COMPETITIONS

### 13.1. Funding Criteria

13.1.1.USA Shooting makes every effort to fund athletes competing in-competition at major international competitions. However, qualifying for a team or a competition does not guarantee funding. USA Shooting may fully fund, partially fund, or not fund an athlete to a competition.

13.1.2. All funding decisions for international competitions will be based on competition priorities (for example, Olympic Quota opportunities) and on Selection rankings.

13.1.3.Only in-competition slots competing for medals are eligible for funding.

### 13.2. Self Funding

13.2.1. Athletes qualifying for a team or a competition may elect to self-fund their participation. The self-funding process is described in the USA Shooting Self-Funding Policies and Procedures.

13.2.2. All out-of-competition slots (Ranking Points Only (RPO) and Minimum Qualifying Score (MQS) slots) will be self-funded.

## 14. PERFORMANCE STANDARD SCORES

Because of the changes in ISSF Rifle equipment rules, there will be no Performance Standard Scores required to be qualify to compete in the Olympic events in ISSF competitions or other international competitions.

## 15. FORCE MAJEURE CONTINGENCY

### 15.1. Force Majeure Contingency for USA Shooting Selection Matches

In the event that USA Shooting is unable to conduct a Selection Match as planned due to extraordinary circumstances beyond the control of USA Shooting (such as natural disasters), USA Shooting may alter the selection procedures upon approval by the USA Shooting Selection Committee, to include reducing courses of fire required for selection.

### 15.2. Force Majeure Contingency for ISSF Competitions and Other Non-ISSF International Competitions

USA Shooting reserves the right to cancel participation in any ISSF competitions or other non-ISSF international competitions to protect the safety and welfare of the athletes and staff. USA Shooting will make these decisions based on the guidance from the US Olympic and Paralympic Committee and the US State Department. A USA Shooting cancellation applies to the entire delegation.

## 16. TEAM USA ATHLETE OMBUDS

The Office of the Athlete Ombuds offers independent, confidential advice to elite Team USA athletes regarding their rights and responsibilities in the Olympic and Paralympic Movement, and assists athletes with a broad range of questions, disputes, complaints and concerns.
